1. This show is sanctioned by the American Dairy Goat Association and its rules shall govern. It is sanctioned for the following breeds: SENIOR DOES: Alpines, LaManchas, Nigerians, Nubians, Oberhasli, Saanens, Toggenburgs and Recorded Grades; JUNIOR DOES: Alpines, LaManchas, Nigerians, Nubians, Oberhasli, AOP and Recorded Grades. There will be two Senior Doe Shows and two Junior Doe Shows. The Senior Shows and Junior Shows are separately sanctioned. Show orders are listed on the following page.
2. The base date is May 24, 2008.
3. Health Regulations: All exhibitors must have a health certificate signed by a veterinarian within 30 days of the show. All animals will be checked for contagious disease (sore mouth, pink-eye, ring worm, open abscess, etc) by the show committee or veterinarian. Any herds exhibiting signs will not be allowed to show. The decision of the show committee is final.
4. The original registration is required for all animals; however, a stamped duplicate will be accepted for all animals under six months of age.
5. Animals must be on the grounds no later than 8:00 AM on May 24, 2008. **Showmanship classes will begin at 8:00 AM sharp with prizes awarded to winners.** Breed classes will begin at 9:00 AM with Sr. Does in both rings, followed by Jr. Does. Arrival on Friday May 23, 2008 will be allowed between 7:00 and 9:00 PM only. Take only your assigned pens and no others.
6. Entry fee is \$4.50 per animal per ring or \$8.00 for both rings. Pre-entry deadline is Monday, May 12, 2008. Late entry fees are \$7 per animal per ring or \$12 for both rings. Substitutions will be allowed within the breed in the same show only. Pen fees are \$5.00 per pen. We make absolutely no money on pens since our club pays \$5 per pen for fair clean-up. Straw is **NOT PROVIDED**. You will need to bring your own bedding. If you are showing any animals from out of your trailer, there is a \$10 non-refundable fee and you need to clean your area before leaving. If bringing Nigerians or small kids, you will need to bring extra fencing as the pens at the fairgrounds can be escaped by small animals.
7. All Best of Breed winners must be present for the Best Doe in Show class.
8. The show committee reserves the right to modify the show order if needed.
9. MDGA, SDGA, ADGA, and the Jefferson County Fairgrounds will not be responsible for loss, damage, or accident to any person or property. Show entry indicates acceptance of all conditions in this form.
10. Dogs will not be permitted in the barns or in or around the show ring area.

**DIRECTIONS:** From I-81 North/South take WV exit #12. Follow route 45 east to route 9 east (towards Charlestown). Approximately 10 miles from I-81 interchange turn right onto Wiltshire Rd at the Bardane Produce Stand. Wiltshire Rd is also marked with signs for the WV State Police and the USDA Res. Station. Follow Wiltshire Rd to the "T" intersection, turn right and the fairgrounds are on the right.

**NEW:** From Maryland I-70/270 follow route 340 west through Harpers Ferry and take a right onto Rt 9 west. **Follow the NEW 4 lane BYPASS west to WILSHIRE RD (RT 8) exit. AT END OF RAMP TURN LEFT on Wiltshire Rd and continue as above.**
